

## Jamie: A Kitchen With More Cabinets and Counter Space

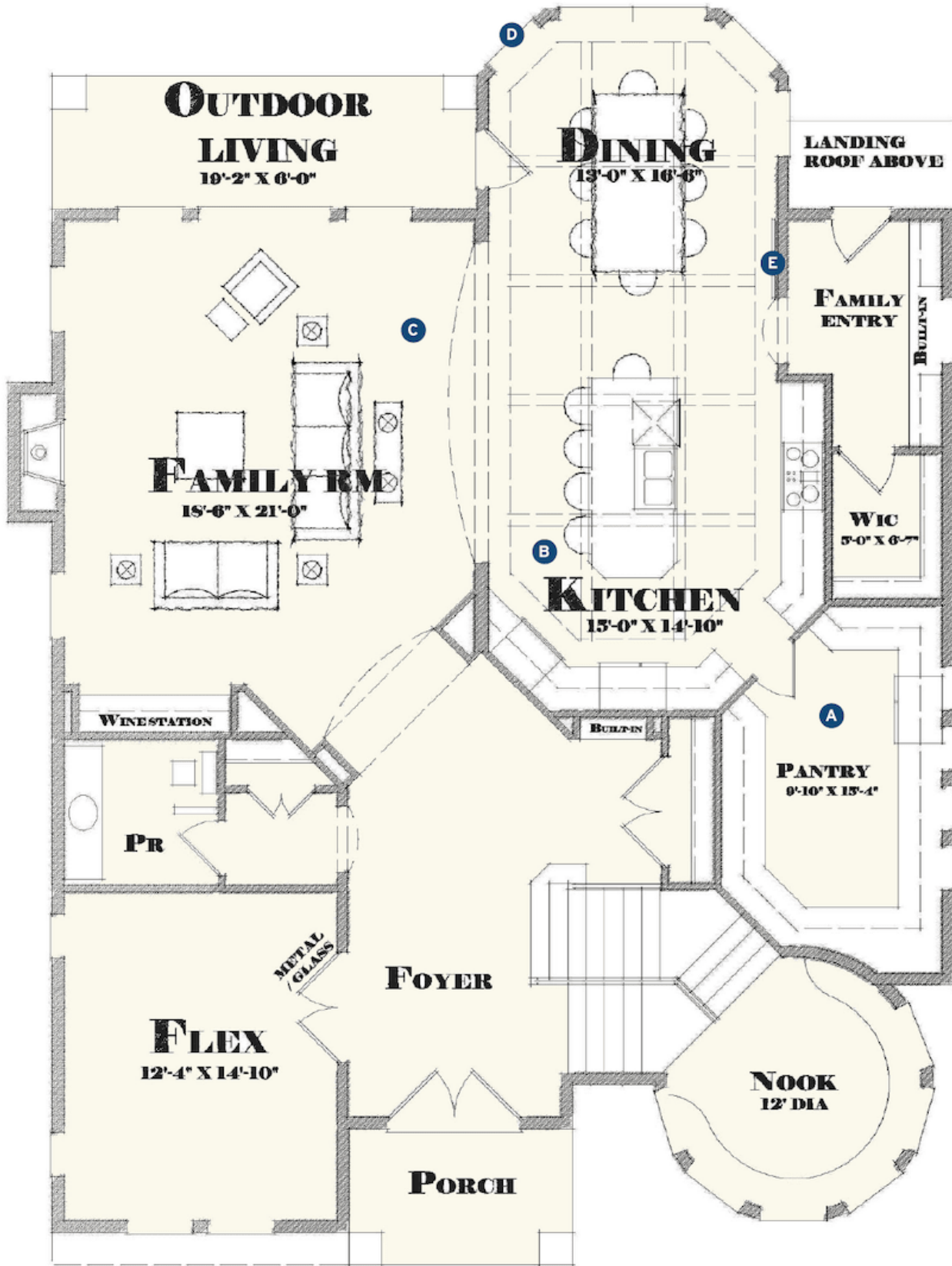
